



COLLEGE BUS RUNS

Parents who wish their student to use the College buses must complete a Bus Use Form (available on the College website and SEQTA) and forward it to administration.

The College has **morning and afternoon bus runs to Darlington, Gidgegannup, Lesmurdie, Midland and Mount Helena**. There is also a free bus that takes students from the Glen Forrest Campus to the Darlington Campus in the morning and in reverse in the afternoon. No token is needed to use the inter-campus bus service.

The bus routes can be downloaded from the website (on the bus runs page) or in hard copy from administration.

For weeks one, two and three of Term One, buses will follow the previous year's routes. Requests to modify or extend the routes or add additional stops should be made in writing to the [Business Manager](#), Michael Papali no later than the end of week two Term One. New routes will be published at the end of week three and take effect from the start of week four.

PAYMENT

Bus travel is paid for using tokens, purchased in advance from administration. Payment can be made in person, over the phone or by email (glenforrest@helenawa.edu.au) using cash, credit card or EFTPOS. Payment CANNOT be added to a student's fees.

Tokens are \$5 each and can be used on any of the bus runs. They may be purchased individually or in groups of 10, 20, 50, 100 or 200 with the following discounts:

200 tokens – \$800.00 (\$4.00 each - 20% discount)

100 tokens – \$425.00 (\$4.25 each - 15% discount)

50 tokens – \$225 (\$4.50 each - 10% discount)

Please note: Where families live outside a designated Public Transport Area they may be eligible for transport assistance through a Conveyance Allowance. Please refer to the Public Transport Authority website for details of eligibility and online application forms.
